# Consumer Electricity Fund

Providing Assistance for Dunedin Residents

## About the fund...

In 1998 the Dunedin City Council, in liaison with agencies providing budget Advisory services set up the Dunedin City Council Consumer Electricity Fund.

The purpose of the fund is to assist people living within the DCC rateable area with a grant towards an electricity account.

There are certain conditions that apply before a grant can be approved.

Application is by appointment only and dependent on eligibility.



# To apply you need to...

- → Be part of an existing budgeting programme and/or complete a budget assessment.
- ✦ Have your eligibility checked by the administrating agency. This can be done by the agency you are working with, or the agency your appointment is made with.
- ◆ Allow at least 30 minutes for your appointment.
- Understand that the grant is generally a one-off.



# The next step...

If you think you are eligible:

- ◆ Talk to your Budget Advisor and they can process the application for you.
- ◆ If you do not have a Budget Advisor, contact one of the agencies listed overleaf.
- ◆ To enable an accurate assessment of your situation, bring all relevant paperwork to the appointment.
